

Vanuatu Citizenship Fees: DSP & CIIP

Obtaining Vanuatu citizenship is a streamlined process that grants applicants a second passport through financial contributions. Below are the current investment requirements for the <u>Development Support Program (DSP)</u> and <u>Capital Investment Immigration Program (CIIP)</u>.

DSP Program: Government Contribution

The Development Support Program <u>(DSP)</u> requires a fixed donation to the Government of Vanuatu.

Contribution Requirements:

- ✔ Single Applicant: \$130,000
- ✔ Married Couple: \$150,000
- ✓ Family with 1 child (<18 years): \$165,000
- ✔ Family with 2 children (<18 years): \$180,000
- ✔ Additional dependents: \$15,000 per person

What's Included in the Fees:

- ✓ Full due diligence screening of the applicant.
- ✓ Official government processing fees for citizenship.
- ✓ Issuance of citizenship certificates.
- ✓ Biometric passports with express courier delivery.
- ✔ Official Oath of Allegiance to Vanuatu.



CIIP Program: Economic Investment

<u>The Capital Investment Immigration Program (CIIP)</u> grants citizenship through investment, combining government fees with a contribution to the Vanuatu Coffee Impact Fund.

Investment Breakdown:

- ✔ Single Applicant: \$155,000
- ✓ Married Couple: \$155,000
- ✓ Family with 1 child (<18 years): \$155,000
- ✔ Family with 2 children (<18 years): \$155,000
- ✔ Additional dependents: \$25,000 per person
